The Curtis Cup is a biennial match conducted by the United States Golf Association featuring 8-player teams with the top female amateurs from the United States and those from Great Britain and Ireland. This details important information that will help you plan and enjoy your experience at Merion.

### Attending the Curtis Cup

The Curtis Cup is free to attend - there are no tickets required to gain entry. A keepsake commemorative ticket will be available on-site.

We encourage golf fans of all ages to join us for what is sure to be a special weekend filled with fantastic golf and camaraderie. Spectators may arrive 30 minutes prior to the first tee time and leave at the conclusion of play. Play will be in the morning and afternoon on Friday and Saturday, June 10-11, and in the afternoon on Sunday, June 12. Specific times will be shared closer to the Match.


### Schedule of Events

Starting times will be posted by the USGA as they are made available closer to the competition. The general schedule is as follows:

- Thursday, June 9 - Opening Flag Raising Ceremony (6 p.m.)**
- Friday, June 10 - Three morning four-ball matches; three afternoon foursomes matches**
- Saturday, June 11 - Three morning four-ball matches; three afternoon foursomes matches**
- Sunday, June 12 - Eight afternoon singles matches; Closing Ceremony**

### **Getting to Merion Golf Club**

Spectators can get to Merion by taking SEPTA's Norristown High Speed Line to Ardmore Avenue Station, which is steps from the Club's entrance at Haverford Road and Ardmore Avenue. Ride-share services such as Uber and Lyft can drop off and pick-up at the Ardmore Avenue SEPTA station (search for Ardmore Av Station - it is not the Ardmore Amtrak station). Limited spectator parking is available at Haverford College - 370 Lancaster Ave, Haverford, PA with shuttle service between the parking lot and Merion Golf Club.

### **Food & Beverage Options**

Snacks and beverages will be available for purchase at two concession locations on the golf course. Card payment only - cash cannot be accepted at concession locations.

### **Merchandise**

Official championship merchandise will be available for purchase in Merion's Golf Shop. Card and cash payment accepted.

### **Junior Activities**

Merion is pleased to partner with the USGA to offer two complimentary Junior Golf Clinics on Saturday, June 11 at Merion's Practice Facility. These clinics have been filled.

Additionally, a Junior Scavenger Hunt will be held throughout the Match to get juniors involved in the competition. Scavenger Hunt Scorecards can be picked up at the Golf Shop, and completed scorecards can be returned to receive a prize. A special Junior Autograph Book will be available for the first 100 juniors each day of Match play for players to sign after the completion of their matches for the day.
